### The Heart Channel

"The Heart holds the office of emperor and is the issuer of spirit clarity."

- Su Wen, Chapter 8


#### **FUNCTIONS OF THE HEART**

- · Commands the blood vessels
- · Stores the shen
- Opens (or "sprouts") to the tongue
- · Governs sweating
- Manifests in the complexion

### **OTHER CHARACTERISTICS**

- Emotion: Joy
- · Affected by: Fright
- · Connected to the uterus via the bao mai

# **Heart Primary Channel**



### Begins: Heart organ

- emerges from the system of blood vessels surrounding the Heart
- Branch: descends to connect Small Intestine
- Branch: ascends alongside esophagus to face, connects to tissue surrounding the eye
- Branch: travels from Heart to Lung then emerges at axilla
- travels down medial aspect of arm to little finger

Linkage: HT-9 → SI-1 Organs: HT, SI, LU


# **Heart Primary Channel**

### **PATHOLOGIES**

- cardiac pain, palpitation, hypochondriac pain
- insomnia, night sweating
- · dry throat, thirst
- pain in the medial aspect of the upper arm
- heat sensation in the palms

Begins	Δ Points	Organs	Tissue	Linkage	Misc.
Heart organ	none	HT, SI, LU	tissue surrounding the eye	HT-9 → SI-1	connects to blood vessels surrounding heart

### **Heart Luo Channel**



### Separates: HT-5

- · connects with SI channel
- follows Heart channel to Heart organ
- continues to root of tongue and eye


### **Deficiency Symptoms:**

• inability to speak (aphasia)

### **Excess Symptoms:**


· fullness and oppression of the chest

# **Heart Divergent Channel**



- Diverges: axillary fossa
- Enters chest and connects to Heart
- Ascends along throat
- Emerges on the face
- Converges with Small Intestine channel at the inner canthus (UB-1)

### **Heart Sinew Channel**



- Originates on the radial aspect of the little finger
- . Binds at the pisiform bone on the wrist
- Binds at the elbow and axilla
- Enters axilla and travels to center of chest
- Descends across diaphragm and terminates at umbilicus

#### **PATHOLOGIES**

- · internal tension
- accumulation below the Heart
- pain, cramping and strain along the course of the channel

# HT-1: jí quán

### 極泉

### **Summit Spring**

### Center of axilla

 $\textbf{Needling:} \perp 0.5\text{-}1.0 \text{ cun}$ 

### **FUNCTIONS:**

- · Unbinds chest
- Nourishes Heart yin and clears deficiency heat
- Activates the channel and benefits the arm

- pain in costal and cardiac regions
- sadness, anxiety, palpitation, agitation, thirst, dry throat
- inability to raise the shoulder, pain in axilla, bi syndrome in the arm, elbow pain

# HT-2: qīng líng



### Green Spirit

3 cun proximal to transverse cubital crease

Needling: ∠ 0.5-1.0 cun

#### **FUNCTIONS:**

ACAP

#### **INDICATIONS:**

 pain in the cardiac and hypochondriac regions, shoulder and arm

### HT-3: shào hǎi



### Lesser Sea

He-Sea (Water) Point

Midway between PC-3 and the medial epicondyle of the humerus

Needling:  $\pm$  0.5-1.0 cun

#### **FUNCTIONS:**

- Clears heat and transforms phlegm to calm shen
- Removes obstruction from the channel and benefits the arm

- cardiac pain, mania and laughter, epilepsy, poor memory, vomiting phlegm
- red eyes, headache, dizziness, toothache
- elbow pain, spasmodic pain and numbness of the hand and arm, trembling or tremor of the hand

# HT-4: líng dào

### Spirit Path

Jing-River (Metal) Point

# 1.5 cun proximal to HT-7, radial side of flexor carpi ulnaris tendon

Needling:  $\pm$  0.3-0.5 cun

#### **FUNCTIONS:**

- · Benefits the voice
- · Calms shen
- · Relaxes the muscles and sinews

#### **INDICATIONS:**

- · sudden loss of voice
- cardiac pain, sadness and fear, restless organ disorder
- pain in arm and elbow, swelling and pain of the fingers, cold sensation in the bones

# **HT-5**: *tōng lĭ*



### Penetrating the Interior

Luo-Connecting Point Ma Dan-Yang Heavenly Star Point

# 1 cun proximal to HT-7, radial side of flexor carpi ulnaris tendon

Needling:  $\pm$  0.3-0.5 cun

#### **FUNCTIONS:**

- · Calms shen
- · Regulates Heart rhythm
- · Benefits the tongue, eyes, and head
- · Benefits uterus and bladder
- ACAP

- · vexation, anger, sadness, fright
- palpitation, pounding of the heart, irregular heart rhythm, dizziness, blurry vision
- sudden loss of voice, aphasia with stiff tongue, stuttering
- red face, red eyes, eye pain
- · uterine bleeding, enuresis
- pain in wrist and elbow

# **HT-6**: *yīn xī*

陰然

### Yin Cleft

Xi-Cleft Point

# 0.5 cun proximal to HT-7, radial side of flexor carpi ulnaris tendon

Needling:  $\pm$  0.3-0.5 cun

#### **FUNCTIONS:**

- Nourishes Heart yin, clears deficiency heat, and stops night sweats
- Regulates Heart blood
- · Calms shen
- · Moderates acute conditions

#### **INDICATIONS:**

- cardiac pain, fullness in the chest, palpitation, sudden loss of voice
- hemoptysis, epistaxis
- · night sweats, steaming bone disorder

### HT-7: shén mén



### Spirit Gate

Yuan-Source Point Shu-Stream (Earth) Point

At the wrist crease, proximal to the pisiform bone, on the radial side of flexor carpi ulnaris

Needling:  $\pm$  0.3-0.5 cun

#### **FUNCTIONS:**

- · Calms shen
- Tonifies Heart (esp. blood)

- insomnia, poor memory
- cardiac pain, palpitation, mad laughter, restless organ disorder, easily frightened, loss of voice
- pain in the lateral costal region, red face, heat in the palms

### HT-8: shào fǔ

少府

### Lesser Palace

Ying-Spring (Fire) Point

Between the 4th and 5th metacarpal bones, where the little finger rests when a fist is made

Needling:  $\perp$  0.5 cun

#### **FUNCTIONS:**

- Clears heat from the Heart and Small Intestine
- · Regulates Heart qi
- · Regulates the uterus
- · Calms shen
- ACAP

#### **INDICATIONS:**

- palpitation, chest pain, fear, agitation, sighing, plum pit qi
- enuresis, dysuria, itching of the external genitalia, uterine bleeding
- heat in the palms
- · spasmodic pain of the little finger

### HT-9: shào chōng



### Lesser Rushing

Jing-Well (Wood) Point

Radial side of little finger, 0.1 cun from corner of nail

Needling:  $\perp$  0.1-0.2 cun, or prick to bleed

#### **FUNCTIONS:**

- Revives consciousness
- Clears heat and benefits tongue, eyes, throat, and face
- Regulates Heart qi and calms shen

- loss of consciousness, cardiac pain, pain in the chest and lateral costal region
- palpitation, mania, excessive sighing
- pain in the root of the tongue, swollen tongue, tongue thrusting, throat pain, eye pain, red eyes
- contraction of the hand, pain in the arm, inability to extend the elbow
